Rule 9 Words that end with the suffix 'ous' When do I use 'tious' or 'cious'

The Golden Rules:

- Not many common words end in 'ious', most end in 'ous' e.g. dangerous.
- E.g. If the root word ends in –ce, the sound is usually spelt as c e.g. malice malicious.
- Eg. If the root ends in t, the spelling will be tious e.g. infectious.





Exceptions:

- Anxious, obnoxious.
